Christ: our understanding of him shapes our world and forms our world-view. It guides the decisions we make, the choices we take. How we know him and how we understand him can create a life of love and generosity, a passion for him and his way.



We can better understand him through our worship together, through prayer and reading and study of the Bible, through conversations and dialogue with brothers and sisters in Christ, through attention to his presence and work in our lives.

But not only is there our understanding of him.

There is also his understanding of us.

Now I know only in part; then I will know fully, even as I have been fully known. (I Corinthians 13:12)

Christ "searches us and knows us," better than we know ourselves. With his understanding of us, he provides for us, comforts us, strengthens us, and guides us. But it is with his understanding, not our own, that he guides us. So, he may direct us in ways that make no sense to us, through valleys and down paths that we would not choose, but he chooses ... for our good.
